Haddock, Vice President of Development for KOTM. “Our main programs, Early Intervention, Early Head Start, Child Care, Respite Care and the KOTM Autism Center provide resources for children with special needs throughout the state” Haddock added.

Kids On The Move traces its roots to 1984. Karen Hahne and Brenda Winegar found few resources for their children with Down Syndrome. Believing that we should expect a bright future for ALL children, Karen and Brenda started the “Up With Downs” Early Preschool, a volunteer parent-run education program for young children with Down Syndrome. Their efforts, and the support of hundreds of parents and professionals, have grown for over three decades and allow KOTM to provide a bright future for all children.

A highlight of the concert will be a vocal solo by Rebecca Winegar, daughter of KOTM founder Brenda Winegar. She will perform *Just Like You* by Janice Kapp Perry and Joy Saunders Lundberg, accompanied by the band. In addition, KOTM Alumni Grace Anderson will direct the band during the march around the park, a crowd favorite at every concert.

Utah Premiere Brass will also perform *Beatles Forever*, *Shepherd’s Hey*, *Over the Rainbow* and many other favorites.
