



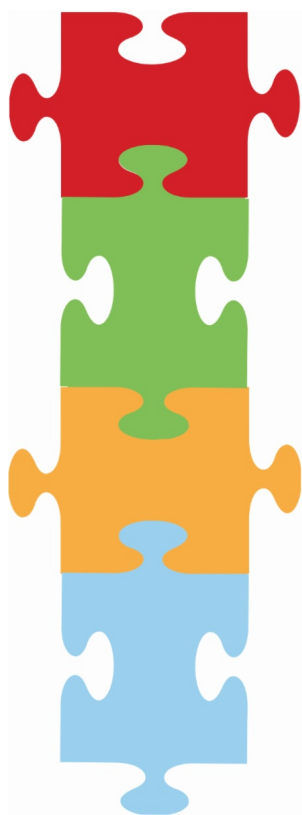

The Four Foundational Pillars of Autism include:

KNOWLEDGE

The third step consists of accepting and embracing these individuals and families into our lives and communities. The Kids On The Move Autism Center grew by 66% this past year despite closing our clinic for part of the year and delivering services primarily in home and via telehealth. We worked diligently with families to accommodate their unique circumstances.



The demand for Autism services in Utah continues to rise with 1 in 33 eight-year-old boys and 1 in 108 eight-year-old girls diagnosed with Autism. (URADD, 2016)
