The Early Head Start program is designed to enhance children's physical, social, emotional, and intellectual development by supporting parents in their critical parental roles. The program aims to help children develop a life long love of learning.

Early Head Start services include: educational, social, medical, dental, nutritional, and mental health, along with parent involvement activities for families. Services are provided in home-based and center-based settings. We believe that parents play the most important role in their children's health and development, as they are their children's best teachers.

Children residing in Utah County under the age of three and pregnant mothers are eligible. Enrollment is based upon income eligibility and other qualifying factors.

The cost of involvement in the program is completely free. Early Head Start does not provide transportation to and from class, socializations, or other events. Parents in the EHS program have the opportunity to receive bus tokens when available and upon request.
